Transnational demonstration on International Human Rights Day

Saturday, 10 December 2022 at 1 pm

Starting point: Auditorium, Göttingen

Murder, war, hunger, exploitation, and environmental destruction prevail in every corner of the world. They are caused by the global capitalist system. States like the USA, Europe, Russia and China - together with their respective allies - divide power over the world among themselves everywhere.

The repression is felt everywhere: here in Europe, but especially in the global South: in Iran, in Kurdistan, in Afghanistan, in Turkey, in Balochistan, in Iraq, in Palestine, in Chile, in Mexico, in Brazil, in Colombia - everywhere.

All struggles for freedom and a dignified life, against social misery and global neoliberal capitalism are suppressed by state attacks, in some places in cooperation with paramilitary gangs like daesh/the IS or the fascist right in Europe.

Neoliberal and colonial economic policies with their imperative of exploitation are responsible for the destruction of the livelihoods of millions and billions of people. A destruction that kills daily and forces people to flee.

- We are witnessing how the NATO partner Turkey is continuously waging a bloody war of extermination against Rojava and all Kurdish women and does not shy away from the massive use of banned chemical weapons against the freedom fighters.

- We are currently witnessing in Iran how the fascist regime and its security forces are brutally attacking the free movements and how the regime is carrying out massacres against the Kurdish and Baluchi population in Kurdistan and Zahedan, for example. In the last three months alone, more than 400 people have been killed and more than 15,000 prisoners are threatened with the death penalty.

- In Afghanistan, we see how the warring NATO countries presented their criminal acts to the world population as "women's liberation" for 20 years. Then power was handed back to the murderous Taliban. The massacre of the Hazara, and other minorities and the oppression of women and girls to the point of femicide characterises Islamic Emirate Afghanistan.

- We see that the Pakistani regime has been committing systematic genocide against Balochistan for years. More than 30,000 Baloch activists in Pakistan have been abducted by the security forces and never reappeared. Political killings are being moved abroad, as evidenced by the murder of journalist Sajid Hussain in Sweden in April 2020 and exiled activist Karima Baloch in Toronto in December 2020.

- We see how the Sudanese mass uprising in 2019 led to the overthrow of the Islamist-military regime of Omar al-Bashir but was subsequently undone by the

military coup led by General Abdel Fattah Burhan, who now brutally cracks down on any social protest by women, homosexuals, ethnic minorities and students*, arresting, torturing and killing people.

- We are witnessing the ongoing colonialism in Abya Yala (America) through land theft, death squads and police terror against small farmers and indigenous people like the Mapuche.

- We are experiencing the consequences of racist and murderous border regimes and increasing military isolation worldwide, including at the EU's external border.

Since the repression of global freedom movements is only possible through the cooperation of oppressive states, our strongest response is:

Global solidarity - together against all tyranny and the imperialist powers!

Let's unite - let's work together on solutions and alternatives!

We are united - by our resistance against state repression and persecution and by our longing for a liberated society!

Important note: Nation-state flags are not welcome, nor are flags of groups collaborating with imperialists.
